Scholarship for the academic year and relocation (national and international) grant application form for the Graduate Programme "Information and Knowledge Society" (IKS)

Second call

Scholarships are available for students of all nationalities to be enrolled in one of the Master degrees that are part of the Graduate Programme. The scholarships are merit-based and open to students having excellent academic records. The scholarship amount is fixed at 3 500€ for the academic year 2021-2022. Students who were not enrolled in a Bachelor or Master degree from the University of Lille in 2020-2021 might be offered an additional relocation grant (3 500€).

Awardees are encouraged to complete an internship in one of the local research units working on the topics of the Graduate Programme Information and Knowledge Society during the M1 or M2 year of studies.

Scholarship applicants must fill and return this application to the Graduate Programme office before : **20th June 2021 (second call)**.

Application for scholarship and application to the master degree are two different procedures. Both must be completed separately.

Candidates currently applying in or willing to apply in one of the 10 Master degrees included in the Graduate Programme can apply for this scholarship.

To apply to the master degree : depending on their country, students must follow the [StudyinFrance \(Campus France\)](#) procedure or the [e-candidat procedure](#).

The Graduate Programme scholarship may not be cumulated with other scholarships such as Erasmus, Labex (Cempi, CAPPa) or MakeOurPlanetGreatAgain (MOPGA) grants.

A FEW WORDS ABOUT THE GRADUATE PROGRAMME « INFORMATION AND KNOWLEDGE SOCIETY».

The Graduate Programmes are track of excellence emphasizing internationalization, interdisciplinarity and employability. The Graduate Programme « Information and Knowledge Society » brings together 10 master degrees in physics and optics, computer science, electronics, mathematics, cognitive sciences and philosophy, etc.

It guides students to prepare their career and to tackle the scientific and technological challenges of our time. They will thus become highly qualified professionals, ready to engage successfully in collaborative projects, mastering one scientific or technological key of a human-friendly digital world while being familiar with the other expertises involved.

Scholarships awarded by the Graduate Programme « Information and Knowledge Society » are available to M1 and M2 students to support their studies (€ 3,500 per year), and to facilitate their settling in Lille (relocation grant from € 1,750 to € 3,500 per year depending on the country of origin). During the master, a scholarship may be awarded to make an internship in a foreign country (amount depending on the country and project, maximum amount € 3,000).
